1.0 PURPOSE

The purpose for Appendix A is to provide a detailed schedule for SBVFD apparatus response within the Silver Bluff Volunteer Fire District and for mutual and auto-mutual aid to surrounding Districts.

This Appendix is used with SBVFD Procedure No. 03-II-002 Emergency Response.

2.0 POLICY

The Silver Bluff Volunteer Fire Department (SBVFD) will maintain adequate emergency and fire protection coverage for the Silver Bluff Volunteer Fire District, District 17.

A specific apparatus response schedule will be developed, maintained, and proceduralized.

3.0 DEFINITIONS

IC – Incident Commander

Mutual Aid – By written agreement, provide and/or receive fire suppression support to or from neighboring fire protection districts.

SBVFD – Silver Bluff Volunteer Fire Department

10-50 – Vehicle accident

10-50 I – Vehicle accident with injuries

10-50 IP – Vehicle accident with pedestrian

10-70A – Structural Fire

10-70B – Brush Fire

10-70C – Vehicle Fire

4.0 PROCEDURE

4.1 SBVFD Stations

4.1.1 Station Location

Station No. 1 District Headquarters, is located on US Highway 278 or at 1119 Williston Road.

Station No. 2 Satellite Station/Training Facility, is located at 2347 Silver Bluff Road.

4.1.2 Station Coverage Area

Station No. 1 Coverage area is from the southern district boundary north to Storm Branch Rd on the West and Graymare Hollow Road to the East of Silver Bluff Road.

Station No. 2 Coverage area is from Storm Branch Rd./Graymare Hollow Rd. north to the Aiken City Fire District boundary (Glenwood Road on Silver Bluff Road).

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4.2 SBVFD Apparatus

The SBVFD has a Headquarters station (Station No. 1) located on US Highway 278 and Satellite Station/Training Facility (Station No. 2) located on Silver Bluff Road.

The SBVFD has a total of four (4) fire apparatus assigned to Station No. 1 and Station No. 2. The following is a listing and description and station assignment of these apparatus:

4.3 10-70A - STRUCTURAL FIRE RESPONSE

Station No. 1

Eng. 3 First out to structure fires (10-70A) in the Fire District.

Station No. 2

Eng. 7 First out for structural fires (10-70A) between Storm Branch/Graymare Hollow Rd. to the south of Sta. No. 2 and Glenwood Road to the northern most extent of the District coverage area.

Eng. 1 Second out to all structure fires (10-70A) in Fire District for all non hydrated areas.

4.4 10-70B – BRUSH FIRE RESPONSE

Truck 2 shall respond to all brush fires within the district because of its unique capabilities. In addition, and at the request of a SBVFD Officer and/or IC, Eng. 3 or Eng. 1 shall be called to provide a source of adequate water supply to aid in the brush fire suppression and for defensive structural posture.

Station No. 1

Truck 2 First out for brush fire (10-70B) in Station No. 1 coverage area and elsewhere in the District at the request of a SBVFD Officer and/or IC.

Eng. 3 Second out for brush fires (10-70B) within Station No. 1 coverage area.

Station No. 2

Eng. 1 First out for brush fires (10-70B) in Station No. 2 coverage area or elsewhere in the District at the request of a SBVFD Officer and/or IC.

Eng.7 Second out for brush fires (10-70B) in Station No. 2 coverage area or elsewhere in District at the request of a SBVFD Officer and/or IC.

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4.5 10-70C – VEHICLE FIRE RESPONSE

Station No. 1

Eng. 3 First out for Vehicle Fire (10-70C) in Station No. 1 coverage area.

Truck 2 Second out to help provide traffic control at the request of a SBVFD Officer and/or IC.

Station No. 2

Eng. 7 First out for vehicle fire (10-70C) in Station No. 2 coverage area.

Eng. 1 Second out, at the request of a SBVFD Officer and/or IC.

4.6 10-50 – MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT RESPONSE

Station No. 1

Eng 3 First out for Vehicle Accident (10-50) in Station No. 1 coverage area unless a SBVFD Officer and/or IC advised otherwise.

Truck 2 Second out to assist with traffic control at the request of a SBVFD Officer and/or IC.

Station No. 2

Eng. 7 First out for Vehicle Accident (10-50) in Station No. 2 coverage area.

Truck 2 Second out to assist with traffic control at the request of a SBVFD Officer and/or IC.

4.7 STRUCTURAL FIRE (10-70A) MUTUAL AID

Station No. 1

Eng. 3 First out on automatic mutual aid calls (Dist 8, 9, 25) inside of surrounding districts city limits where fire hydrants are in place, and for standby for surrounding districts.

Station No. 2

Eng. 1 First out for mutual aid calls for water supply and on automatic aid to surrounding districts.

Eng. 7 First out on automatic mutual aid calls to Dist. 4 and first out to Aiken City for standby or mutual aid.

4.8 BRUSH FIRE (10-70B) MUTUAL AID

Truck 2 Responds for all mutual aid requests for brush truck.
